NASA: WHAT'S NEW FOR 2019? BY AMY PIPER

ccording to Trena Ferrell, Ph.D., the Earth are Wednesday through Friday in Holmes A Science Division Education and Public Outreach Lead, "NASA is drawn to Odyssey because it's a win-win. We want the world to know the great work our scientists and engineers are doing. We also want to check out what the next generation is doing."

To this end, NASA is sending a diverse 30-person team this year to OotM. They represent a variety of NASA centers, as well as many different positions. This team will lead classroom sessions, virtual and in-person science talks, and participate in the Creativity Festival.

NASA's 2019 program includes science talks. The NASA science talks have open seating, so you won't need to register ahead of time, and they don't require a ticket. Science talks Hall C106. They are the perfect way to spend some downtime learning.

You'll find both in-person and virtual presentations. Virtual presentations are new for 2019 and include NASA Trees, Clouds Impact on Earth's Energy Budget, and Science Behind the Music. In-person presentations include: Getting the Buzz about Mosquitos, Viewing Earth from Space with Landsat, NASA Citizen Science, and NASA's Global Precipitation Measurement Mission.

NASA will also participate in the Creativity Festival, where students can learn how satellites view Earth through hands-on student demonstrations. Another new activity for 2019, at the Creativity Festival, is a photo opportunity. Students should be sure to find the Moon pop-up, designed as a selfie photo opportunity to celebrate NASA's return to the Moon.

If your team wants some last-minute practice with spontaneous problems, check out the NASA-centric examples on the NASA OotM 2019 website.

Ferrell loves the energy she finds when coming to WF. Meeting the students and educators in-person provides a chance to develop relationships that last beyond just the OotM week. In the past, educators have had follow-up conversations with her after Odyssey. Dr. Ferrell has even hosted groups at NASA Goddard after the event so that groups could continue the learning that began at Odyssey.

OotM & MSU TEAM UP TO BE SPARTAN GREEN

Michigan State University welcomes • Metal, includes wire mesh, soda cans, and other kinds of metals. Odyssey of the Mind competition. As a resident on campus you are now a Green Spartan.

As a Green campus we encourage you to lessen your impact on the environment by taking some simple steps that will keep Michigan State University clean and green.

Here is how you can help:

Reduce/Reuse- Bring a refillable water bottle and refill at our hydration stations rather than purchasing bottled water. Turn off the lights when you leave a room. Turn the water off while brushing your teeth.

Recycle- The MSU Recycling and Surplus Center allows our campus to divert over 60% of our waste from landfill. When taking apart your props please be mindful and put it in the appropriate recycling bins.

It is your responsibility to put material into the recycling containers. MSU recycles the following material:

- Office paper
- Mixed paper/boxboard, cardboard, newspapers
- All plastics, Plastics include items such as plastic grocery bags, shrink wrap, bubble wrap, etc.
- Glass
- Cloth

- If you created something unusual that has re-use potential, let us know.
- Additionally, all plastic and metal carbonated beverage containers can be recycled.

Prop unpacking and assembly areas will have special recycling containers to make recycling in the prop room easy. Please read the signs and utilize our co-mingled recycling containers in the prop areas and divert items from the landfill.

If you want to save your prop for shipping home, we will have signs onsite for you to do so.

Re-educate- There will be signs all over campus to help Odyssey participants understand how to divert materials from the landfill and Be Spartan Green. Be a role model through your actions and take the lead on being Spartan Green: reduce, reuse, recycle.

**Please note: For your safety, Odyssey participants and guests are instructed to stay out of back dock and dumpster areas. Odyssey participants found in these areas will immediately be disqualified from the competition.

TEAM DINING AND HOUSING

You will be assigned to a specific residence hall and dining center for your meals at Wednesday - Saturday: team registration. All persons staying in a residence hall will be issued a color-coded wristband for use of recreation areas, and Conference Card allowing them into the appropriate dining center, as well as living wing access. For those staying off campus, but wishing to eat in a residence hall, cash and credit cards are accepted at each entrance host.

Many special dietary needs can be accommodated by simply choosing appropriately from the wide variety of choices that will be available at each meal. If you have a team member with a medically required dietary need (such as a food allergy), please make contact with either the Dining Manager or Executive Chef of your dining hall. The staff in Culinary Services are well versed in dietary needs, and can assist in making appropriate menu choices.

Upon entry, please have your Conference Card ready. Each Conference Card can only be used once per meal period. It is important to immediately report lost Conference Cards, due to the living wing and elevator access. Report lost cards to the Service Center of your hall. You will be issued a replacement Conference Card immediately. There is a lost Conference Card fee of \$10.00 US, which will be tracked and billed to the team by Odyssey of the Mind.

- It is a combo exchange option for lunches only.
- Between 10:30am and 4pm go to any open Sparty's location on campus, the food courts at the International Center and Union, and 1855 Place Sparty's Market and swipe your conference card to receive a combo exchange option for lunch. You must have your conference card for this option and it must be done between 10:30am and 4pm. This will replace your lunch at your residence hall.

Maintenance concerns should be reported to the Service Center of the residence hall. Maintenance teams are on site from 6:00am through midnight, daily to handle any facilities concerns. Emergency maintenance can be called in after midnight, as warranted.

To keep pintrading a positive experience for everyone, it is extremely important that participants 3. If someone wants to make a trade with abide by these rules:

- 1. Respect others. Not everyone at World Finals trades pins, and there are always teams preparing to compete that should not be distracted.
- 2. Trade pins in designated pin-trading areas. Do NOT trade pins in any area marked "No Pin Trading."
- 3. Pin-trading is not allowed at the team entrance or spectator entrance to any performance site. It is not allowed in any stairwells, doorways, or entrances to buildings. It is also not allowed in any area where teams compete or where others gather to watch teams compete. If you are in a designated pin-trading area in a hallway, be sure to allow enough room for people to pass by.
- 4. If an Odyssey of the Mind or University Official asks you to stop trading pins or to move from an area, you must honor that person's request.
- 5. Selling pins is not allowed.
- 6. Never taunt others by criticizing a trade, any pin someone is trading, or anyone's collection.
- 7. If you trade in a location where pintrading is not allowed, or tease others about their pins and trades, your pin collection may be confiscated. If your collection is confiscated, you will be able to pick it up the following morning at the Odyssey of the Mind Information booth. Only Odyssey of the Mind officials, your parents, or your coach may confiscate your pin collection.
- 8. Do not trade with Odyssey of the Mind Officials while they are working.
- 9. Do not pressure anyone into a trade.
- 10. Please show your Odyssey of the Mind Spirit when trading pins. Do not take advantage of youngsters or first-time traders. If only fair trades are made, the Odyssey of the Mind World Finals experience will be all the better for everyone. If you find lost pins, please take them to the Odyssey Information booth.

 - you and tells you that you will be making a great deal, you probably are not being offered an equal trade.
 - 4. Pins are traded up until the time you leave for home.
 - 5. Have something to keep your pin collection in or on. Official World Finals pin towels and pin bags are available at the Odyssey of the Mind souvenir centers. Make sure you write your name somewhere on your collection in case you misplace it. If you happen to misplace it, notify the Odyssey of the Mind Information Booth.

SHIPMENT TRACKING:

STEP 1: Check your carrier's website to monitor the status of your shipment. When delivery to MSU is confirmed, proceed to Step 2.

STEP 2: Log on to U-Track at usd.msu. edu/logistics/u-track. Enter your carrier's tracking number in the Carrier's Tracking Number field and click U-Track It! It is your responsibility to have record of your tracking number as MSU is unable to assist without it.

When your shipment arrives at MSU's receiving dock, props will be stored in the warehouse pending delivery to your prop storage and assembly site.

U-Track will display "Odyssey 2019 Delivered" when it has reached your prop storage and assembly location.
