



# HEALTH SERVICES

Attached is the medical release form that is required for every participant and must be signed by his or her parent/guardian. These will be kept on file on campus so that, in the event special services are required, all necessary information will be on hand. Please bring your team's completed forms with you to registration. Forms are required and participants will not be allowed to register without the completed release form.

## **THIELEN STUDENT HEALTH CENTER**

The Thielen Student Health Center is located on the corner of Union Drive and Sheldon (west edge of campus, directly west of Beyer Hall, across the street from State Gym.) Phone number: 515-294-7973. First aid and minor illness care is included in your fees. If incident requires further diagnostic work, a fee will be billed to participants or their insurance company. Limited prescription medications are available.

## **MARY GREELEY MEDICAL CENTER**

Medical care also is available through the emergency room of Mary Greeley Medical Center, located at 12th Street and Duff Avenue. The fees and billing structure are typical of an emergency community medical facility.
